Question 1

Does the INFINITIVE end with a /t/ or /d/ SOUND?

Does the INFINITIVE **END** with.....EITHER

.... a VOICED sound? (= uses the voice-box, it vibrates in the throat; Includes all vowel sounds)

.... an UNVOICED sound? (= DOESN'T USE the voice-box, ALL SOUNDS from the mouth)
